The Yuma County Sheriff's Office is now accepting applications for our Detentions Division! Working in the jail is a great way to start and grow your law enforcement career. We offer many opportunities for supplemental training and certifications including Taser, other less lethal munitions, Gracie Survival Tactics (Jiu Jitsu), multi-platform armorer courses, and more. Jail staff are also eligible to try out for our tactical SPEAR Team after they complete the required probationary period.

Candidates must be able to perform physical tasks and are preferred to have moderate computer skills. Daily tasks may include but are not limited to booking and bonding inmates, serving meals, dispensing medication, coordinating paperwork with the courts, performing cell shakedowns, and transporting inmates. Substantial training hours at the shooting range can also be expected.

Starting salary is \$18 per hour. There is a \$500 bonus at the end of 90 days and a \$1,000 bonus at one year. The Sheriff's Office also provides excellent benefits and insurance packages including vision and dental.
