Patrol Deputy Position

If you are interested in a career in law enforcement in a rural setting the Yuma County Sheriff's Office is now accepting applications for the position of Patrol Deputy. We are looking for self-motivated individuals who are interested in making a difference in their community. The Sheriff's Office is a family first organization that places a high value on the training of its deputies.

Duties performed by deputies are listed below but not limited to:

- Responding to calls for service involving in progress criminal activity in the county
- Investigations into theft, assaults, burglaries & other reported crimes in the county— these can be minor offenses to serious felonies
- Service of civil papers
- Write clear and concise reports detailing facts of investigations.

Deputies are encouraged to be proactive in investigating crimes in Yuma County and will also assist other law enforcement agencies in the performance of their duties. They also must be willing to work shift work, weekends, holidays and be on call.

Applicants must be 21 years old, be Colorado POST certified, have a High school diploma or GED and possess a valid driver's license. Starting pay is approximately \$43,680 per year.
